General Information

After-School Tutoring:

MHS offers supervised after-school tutoring and quiet study opportunities every day from 2:30 - 3:30 pm. Transportation home is provided at 3:45 pm for students who are eligible to ride the bus (live more than 1 mile from the building). At 3:30 pm, students who require a bus to take them home will be given a transportation ticket from the Supervising Teacher and can take that ticket to Maumee Intermediate School to catch a bus. During the 2023-2024 school year we had over 1100 students show up to after school tutoring this school year.

Student Assessments & Academic Intervention Services:


