XC District Championships

The girls cross country team made history on October 30, 2021 when they competed and triumphed at their district championship! The district this year consisted of 18 different school and fielded teams such as the 16th-ranked-in-the-state Montverde Academy. Regardless, the girls team broke out and dominated the district race and birthed their teams first ever girls cross country district championship. Some might say, “Never in 100 years,” but for Mount Dora High School’s 100th anniversary, these ladies made it happen!

The team placed 1st overall with only 28 points beating out Montverde who finished 2nd place with 46 points. The team was led by Freshman Hannah Douglas, the individual district champion, and Sophomore Noelle Vu who placed 2nd. They were followed by Senior Caitlin Foley who placed 6th, Roxxi Ottum in 7th, Taralynn Hubler in 12th, Cadence O’Neil in 22nd, Cecelia Zagorini in 28th, and Ella Makinson in 50th.

In November, the girls team had a strong showing at states and continued to make history, placing 2nd overall and taking home the region’s runner-up trophy.



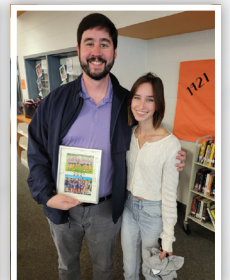

The girls cross country team competed at the state championship on Friday, November 12. The girls team entered the meet ranked 9th in the state after our regional loss to Satellite High School.

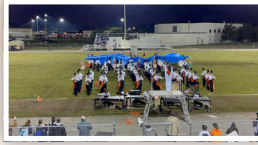

Criminal Justice Classes

The Criminal Justice classes investigated and solved their first Missing Persons case on November 16, 2021. Fictional MDHS student, Missi Ng was last seen on campus at 10:24 am on November 15, 2021. Criminal Justice student detectives first interviewed the victim’s parents. Teacher Assistants volunteered to play the roles of Missi’s mom and dad. Detectives then posted a Missing Person Poster featuring a photo and pertinent information.

Missi’s mom provided evidence from the home that indicated Missi may have been having problems with a best friend and ex boyfriend. Additional interviews with friends, teachers, and students walking with Missi before she disappeared helped detectives to get a better sense of the situation.

While following these leads, detectives discovered a potential crime scene near the Building 4 first floor bathrooms. They were quick to process the evidence found, take photographs and make detailed sketches of the crime scene. Detectives ultimately solved the case by finding Missi at a friend’s house skipping school. Missi, along with her best friend and ex boyfriend, may face fictional criminal charges for staging a fake crime scene.

Aspen Burch stated, “Getting out of the classroom and taking real photos was a lot of fun.”

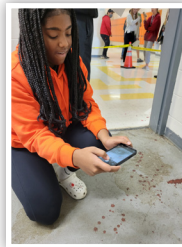


MDHS student artists Eden Solomon and Lili Martinez created the “evidence” in Missi Ng’s sketch book.

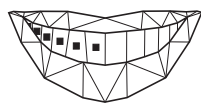

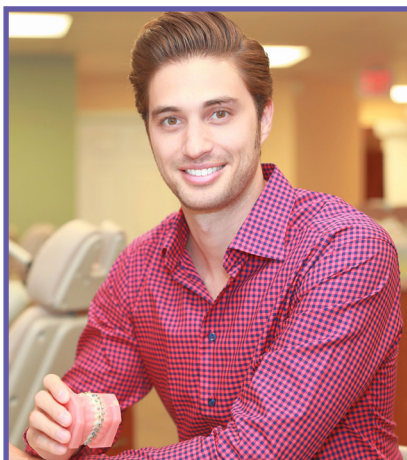
