Mental Health

Hello Parents and Students,

My name is Dr. Clinkscales, and I am the new *Mental Health Liaison* for Mount Dora High School. Some of you may already know me, because I was your child's school counselor last year. In this new role, I am able to meet with students to discuss their emotional, social, and mental health concerns that may impede academic success.

As the mental health liaison (MHL) for the school, I work with teachers to integrate Restorative Practices/Circles that are utilized to build relationships in the classroom between students and teachers. At MDHS we utilize this district initiative to get to know our students. It is important to seek understanding, listen, and then give feedback to affirm our students. Restorative circles can be utilized for the following: relationship building, conflicts, and with content to asses a deeper level of thinking. Restorative Circles help to build self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, and relationship skills. This process allows student to be heard, repair the harm and build community.

In addition to Restorative practices, individual counseling, group counseling, referrals to on site/ off campus therapists are a part of what I do here at MDHS. In the event of a crisis, as the MHL

I will mediate, and contact parents and other personnel necessary to ensure student safety, as well as follow up with services. Awareness and prevention are vital to help our students navigate through highschool, peer interactions, and academics in this technology driven society. I look forward to working with you this year to help our students achieve Wellness as well as academic success!
