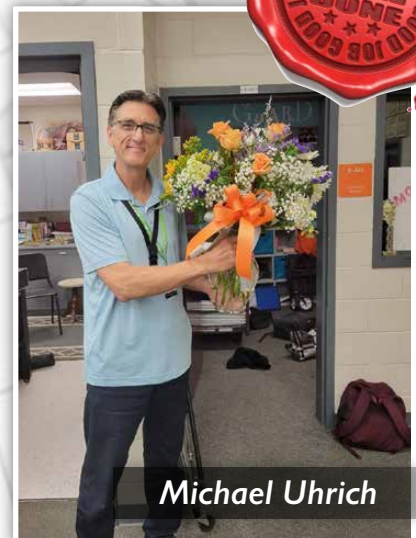

Out of Field Teachers

Out of Field Teachers Florida state law requires that Mount Dora High School notify a parent or guardian when a teacher in a district school system is assigned teaching duties dealing with a subject matter that is outside the field in which the teacher is certified. Mr. Segalini, Mrs. Holmes, Mrs. Schichtel, Ms. Larkin, and Mrs. Santiago meet the criteria for parental notification under this law. All of these teachers are currently finishing their required certifications. Once complete, they will no longer be considered 'out of field.' Based upon a review of these teacher's educational and career background, Mount Dora High School's administration believes they are qualified to successfully deliver instructional services to their assigned students. 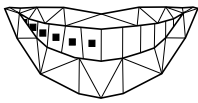
