LETTER FROM THE DRINCIPAL

Dear Parent/Guardians.

As we begin the third nine weeks marking period, we are implementing many new goals, initiatives, state mandates, etc. It is my goal to communicate these to you in a timely manner. When we are all in the know, we can work collaboratively to help all students succeed. I encourage you to follow what takes place at OBMS via Facebook and Twitter. Beginning in January, all students will be receiving five hours of mental health training as is required via the state. Students in 6th and 8th grades will be meeting this requirement through their Social Studies classes. While 7th graders, will meet this requirement through their Science classes. The state mandate requires the mental health hours take place in a core subject class.

Our student ID grace period has ended. All students are to wear and display their school issued ID once they enter the school gate. Students without an ID will be sent to the house office for a dated ID sticker. We do have consequences established to help our students remember the ID procedure. Students have been encouraged to keep their ID in their backpack when removing it at the end of the day. If your child has lost his/her ID, we can make replacement IDs at the school for a minimal cost.




Chess Club






Second Semester



Paper makeup testing for Grade 6 Reading and Math can continue through Friday, May 15th and Grade 8 Science can continue through Friday, May 22nd. Session 1 must always be administered before session 2.

CBT makeup testing for Grades 7 and 8 Reading and Math and all EOCs can continue through Friday, May 29th. Session 1 must always be administered before session 2. You cannot administer two sessions in one day (except for the second day of math), the platform won't let you.

*Pearson NGSSS EOC: Civics NGSSS EOCs are administered in one day. Students must sit for an initial 80 minutes, at that point if they are finished, they can be dismissed, if not, they can have another 80 minutes and if at that point they are not done they may have up to the full day to finish if needed. This is for all students.

**FSA EOCs: Algebra 1 and Geometry FSA EOCs are 2 sessions over 2 days and session 1 must always be administered before session 2. You cannot administer two sessions in one day to the same student, the platform won't let you. All students may have up to half of a school day (2 1/2 hours) to finish if needed.
