LETTER FROM THE DRINCIPAL

Hello, Panther Families.

What an amazing start to the school year! Our panthers are thriving and getting into the groove so well. It is so nice to see their smiling faces each morning as they come in ready and prepared to learn. We have some great new initiatives in place for the school year as part of the middle school redesign and we are already noticing a positive change. Open House was fabulous, and we truly appreciate everyone's patience with the new security procedures. I hope everyone enjoyed meeting their students' teachers and checking out their classrooms.

As part of the middle school redesign, Volusia County middle schools have gone to a teaming approach. Every child is part of a team. The students on the team share the same core subject area teachers except for math in 7th and 8th grades. Some students may have to go off their team for math instruction. The purpose of moving to the teaming concept is to create a better support system for our students, better communication with families, team spirit, and a positive learning environment. It is long overdue to bring the fun back to middle school!!!

Another great initiative in middle schools across the county is the implementation of Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS). PBIS is an approach used to promote school safety and good behavior. We teach students about behavior expectations and strategies. The focus of PBIS is prevention, not punishment. You will notice that most student IDs have a bar code on the bottom, we can scan the bar code and give students PBIS points on an app. Students can then use these points to purchase privileges (lunch with a friend outside, pizza with the principal, school store items, discounts on school events, etc). We will be teaching and reviewing specific behavior and safety expectations throughout the year. Ask your students if they have earned any PBIS points yet.

For students to be able to learn to their full potential, we have to provide a safe and secure school campus. Students participated in expectation assemblies at


