Our staff has worked extremely hard to get our school ready for the start of school on August 12th and I would like to thank each of them for their efforts during our preparations over the summer.

I am very excited about this school year. It has been an outstanding journey and I am proud to say that many of our students will be part of our Cambridge AICE program after our official designation earlier this spring. The Cambridge curriculum will enable our students to accelerate their academic standing and be better prepared and competitive when they transition to college, trade schools, military enlistment, and the work force. Our Cambridge instructional staff is eager to begin implementing this program with our students.

Although our school grade has not been officially released from spring testing, early data suggests there continues to be work needed to improve our standing in some of the core academic areas. There are, however, some outstanding achievements made this past school year. In the world of Advanced Placement (AP) our school recorded 314 exams passed with a pass rate of 55%; the most ever in school history. Our students earned over 130 industry certifications which is a number that continues to improve each year. Our school was again named "Best High School" by the US News and World Report a distinction that only 20% of all schools earn across the nation. We will continue to build upon our successes and work incredibly hard on our weaknesses to improve the lives of our students.

I want to welcome all of our new Pirates, the members of the Freshmen Class, 2023. We are excited to have you aboard and look forward to all of your contributions over the next four years. There are two things that will help you as you transition in becoming a Pirate. First, make sure throughout your first year of school that you do all you can to maintain good grades. 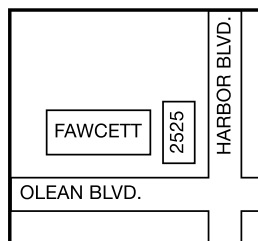
