A few decades ago, when I was working on my undergraduate degree, I took several psychology courses. Some of the content was commonsense and seemingly sound; some was downright dubious and laughable! As a result, I have always been suspicious of the newest fads in "pop psychology." Nonetheless, one premise that I walked away with so many years ago had a profound impact on my life. It came from a school of thought known as "symbolic interactionism," and one of its tenets goes like this: What you say influences how you feel more than how you feel influences what you say. Please dwell on that for a moment.

When we spend our time and energy complaining, criticizing, and speaking negatively, we don't feel better about ourselves; we feel lousy. On the other hand, when we find the positive in life and spend our energy stating that which we are grateful for, our emotions rise!

A corollary to this suggests that our most commonly held formula for success is broken. Conventional wisdom holds that if we work hard we will be more successful, and if we are more successful, then we'll be happy. If we can just find that great job, win that next promotion, lose those five pounds, happiness will follow. But recent discoveries in the field of psychology have shown that

this formula is actually backward: Happiness fuels success, not the other way around. When we are positive, our brains become more engaged, creative, motivated, energetic, resilient, and productive at work. This discovery has been repeatedly borne out by rigorous research in psychology and neuroscience, management studies, and the bottom lines of organizations around the globe.

As a staff, we have been reading Shawn Achor's recent book, The Happiness Advantage. In it, Achor explains how we can reprogram our brains to become more positive in order to gain a competitive edge at school or work. I sincerely want all our students to excel in a world of increasing workloads, stress, and negativity. Perhaps you'll want to explore The Happiness Advantage for yourself. It discusses how to reap the benefits of a happier and more positive mind-set to achieve success in school, our work, and in our lives.

No matter how the next couple of months unfolds for you, here's to the most productive spring ever! May your days be filled with optimism and hope!


