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Driver Education

BEHIND THE WHEEL

If your HS student has their driver's permit, they need to take advantage of Behind the Wheel. It is a course that is taught all year long and during the summer. Classes run from 3 to 6 on Mon, Tues, Thurs, and Fri for 7 days in a row. New classes start every two weeks.

- 1. Students get 10 hours of actual drive time with a certified instructor.
- 2. Most auto insurance companies offer a discount for having taken the course.
- Safety protocols have been implemented to keep us safe and masks must be always worn while in the car.
- 4. It is totally FREE to all Lake county residents (even virtual and home-schooled students are welcome to take the course)
