

Dear Eagle Family,

As we conclude this first half of the 2023-24 school year and prepare for the start of the second semester, I want to thank our SLHS faculty and staff for their continued perseverance and dedication to meeting the needs of our students, as well as serving you and our school community. In celebration of our school's 30th anniversary, we were thrilled to welcome back and honor each of the previous SLHS principals at the October 27 varsity football game against East Ridge HS: David Coggshall, David Tucker, David Bordenkircher, and Robert McCue. On that evening, we also inducted the inaugural class into the SLHS Athletic Hall of Fame: athletes Aurora Davis, Jeff Demps, Jeff Deardorff, and Jonotthan Harrison; coach Bobby Heck; and community member Jack Gaines. We are grateful to each of these individuals for their contributions to SLHS and for the legacy they have left for our students.

Overall, the students have adapted well to the legislative change that bans cell phones in the classroom, adjusted to the new FOCUS student information system, and navigated the changes in bell schedules to accommodate three lunch periods and SOAR time, which is our additional period within the school day for remediation and acceleration purposes. I am extremely appreciative of your patience and flexibility as we encountered increased student enrollment this semester, which led to additional teacher hiring at the beginning of the school year and the corresponding schedule changes that were necessary to balance classes.

As we return from winter break, we will begin preparations for the upcoming 2024-25 school year and the process for soliciting student course selections and academic scheduling opportunities. Please have conversation with your child as you collaboratively develop the academic course plan that will best meet their needs and future goals. Our guidance counselors will be making presentations to current SLHS students in their classes over the next few months, visiting our feeder middle schools to speak with 8th grade students, and working with you to accommodate course requests as best as possible. Please be on the lookout for course request and scheduling information as it becomes available, and feel free to peruse our SLHS Curriculum Guide on the Student Services page of our school's website. This fall, we entered a partnership with Beacon College in Leesburg to provide on campus dual enrollment opportunities for students with disabilities.
