Just one week later on October 13, 2018, the Regiment followed up that victory with an amazing fifth place overall finish at the Bands of America Orlando Regional competition! Proceeds from the ticket sales will help to fund scholarships for our students and will provide funds for the maintenance and general upkeep of our Performing Arts Center.








