#### **IT'S COURSE SELECTION TIME!**

Our counselors are spending the months of February and March meeting with students to discuss their course selections for next school year. This springtime, counselors will be meeting with seniors one final time for their exit interview and one last graduation check. It is important that all seniors leave WPHS with a plan in place for life after graduation, whether it be post-secondary education, military or the workforce. Juniors will also be registering for the Collegeboard Opportunity Scholarship. Collegeboard provides incentives in the form of scholarship giveaways for students who complete college exploration and college readiness tasks, such as creating a college list, completing test prep through Khan Academy and improving their SAT scores.

Many colleges and universities are visiting WPHS once again this spring to meet with juniors. All students are encouraged to explore their options by attending college visits. Students can sign up on SCOIR and stop by the CCC if they have any questions or need assistance. Sophomores will be spending time on SCOIR exploring careers and colleges and universities.


