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

WSHS PROGRAM OF EMPHASIS COURSE OFFERINGS

PLEASE SIGN UP for the following course to become part of the WSHS Renewable Energy Program:

ETP 2502 ALTERNATIVE ENERGY SOURCES – DUAL ENROLLMENT with SSC – Open to <u>ALL</u> Grade levels!

Student will receive 3 college credits and high school credit. This course is taken at WSHS and counts like an AP class for GPA, but is NOT AP and has NO exam at the end!

Prerequisite: None. Grades 9-11

MUST BE concurrently enrolled in another science class.

1 Elective Science Credit Grades 9-12

This is an introductory course for students interested in renewable energy and climate change. The curriculum includes topics such as home efficiency, wind energy, solar (thermal and photovoltaic) energy, hydroelectric energy, bioenergy, tidal and wave power, geothermal energy, and fuel cells. Also studied are the environmental and economic impacts of renewable energy. 9th graders are encouraged to take this course as a beginning to a 4-year program of emphasis on renewable and solar energy.

How to Sign up:

ETP 2502 ALTERNATIVE ENERGY SOURCES - DUAL ENROLLMENT with SSC

Students who sign up for this course will be put into Experimental Science 1 (2002340) HONORS (that will be the name of the course for the 1st semester only) for 1st Semester and will transition into ETP 2502 for 2nd Semester (due to the college course being only 1 semester, or .5 credit), and students will work on the dual enrollment college curriculum 1st semester as well to get a head start on 2nd semester. This allows us more time for labs and activities. 1st semester is Honors Credit, 2nd semester is Dual Enrollment (AP credit). So, students will be receiving high school credit 1st semester and college credit (3 hours) for 2nd semester.

Reasons to take Alternative/Solar Energy Dual Enrollment Courses at WSHS:

- 1. No homework.
- 2. Lots of labs and activities.
- 3. Free college credit without having to pass an exam at the end.
- 4. Courses are taken on the WSHS campus with Mr. Johnson.
- 5. Honors and AP GPA weighting.
- 6. Open-book tests/quizzes.
- 7. Open to ALL grade levels.

4 Year, 5 Course Sequence:

9th Grade: ETP 2502 Alternative Energy Sources (Open to grades 9-12)

10th Grade: ETP 2410 Photovoltaic Systems (Solar Electric) (Open to grades 10-12)

11th Grade: ETP 2420 Solar Thermal Systems (Solar Heating) (Open to grades 11-12)

12th Grade: Fall- ETP 2050 Energy Analysis; Spring: ETP 2910C Projects in

Sustainability**

**The 12th grade courses are for 4th year students who have completed the first 3 courses in the Program of Emphasis. All students should check the curriculum guide for more information.

When someone in a developing country becomes an amputee – they quickly come to realize they have lost much more than a limb. The loss of a limb is just the first loss in a cycle of loss that often includes their job, social standing, self-worth, family, dignity, and finally their humanity. Let's break that cycle!

Most of us don't even think about it. We take thousands of steps every day. It's just a part of life. But for millions of amputees throughout the developing world, the possibility of taking a single step is just a dream.

Making a global impact:

Here at Winter Springs High School, we started the sock campaign to help give amputees around the world a second chance at life. Working with We Help Two, we are providing them with a leg system that is high-quality and costs less than the cell phone that we carry around in our pockets every day.

We are selling packs of socks to raise money for these prosthetic legs. Each pair costs \$10 and will be available for either delivery or pickup by mid March. Last year, we raised enough money for two legs for well-deserved kids in India and Ghana, so we hope to make a difference again!
